Spring is in the air, and the summer is fast approaching! As the school year is coming to an end, we look back and see what a great year we had!

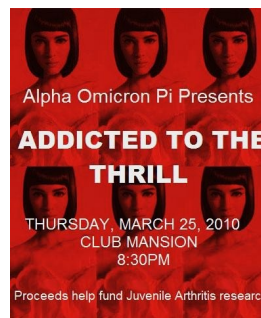
